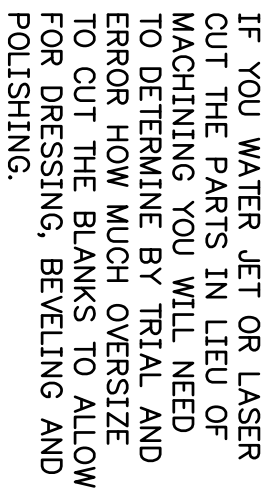

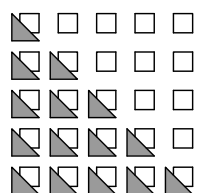


STYLE I

1. THIS STYLE FORK SYSTEM IS USUALLY ATTRIBUTED TO ALDEN NESS BUT WAS POPULAR FOR TRIKES IN THE EARLY 60'S. LITERALLY THOUSANDS OF THESE FORKS WERE MADE IN DOZENS OF VARIATIONS OVER THE YEARS BY SEVERAL DIFFERENT COMPANIES AND INDIVIDUAL SMALL SHOPS BUT FEW ORIGINALS SURVIVE TODAY. THE PATTERNS SHOWN HEREIN WERE TAKEN FROM SEVERAL EXAMPLES OF THE WORK THAT HAVE COME INTO OUR SHOP OVER THE YEARS AND REPRESENT TYPICAL EXAMPLES OF THE STYLE.
2. EVEN THOUGH I HAVE BUILT THESE FORKS FOR SHOW BIKES IT WAS MY RESPONSIBILITY TO POINT OUT THAT THE DESIGN HAS SOME STRUCTURAL ISSUES COMPARED TO THE LATE 19TH CENTURY STYLE SO IF YOU BUILD TO THE OLD ORIGINAL CONFIGURATION YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK.
